

Minutes of Regular Meeting

New Business was conducted:

The council discussed/considered an invoice in the amount of \$6415.53 from the Grimes County Elections Registrar for the cities portion of the May 3<sup>rd</sup> Election. Motion by Becky Evans to approve to pay. Second by Wayne Cadro. Motion carries unanimously.

No action was needed on the discussion regarding the generator that was turned over to the IVFD at a previous meeting.

Discussion and review of the final FY 23-24 audit results from CPA firm Davis and Heinemann & Co. Motion to accept the results as written by Becky Evans, second by Wayne Cadro. Motion carries unanimously.

No action needed on the discussion and preliminary review of the FY 2025-2026 budget.

The council discussed invoices to the UMB Bank (\$10,000.00 for Series 2023)(\$5,000.00 for Series 2020) totaling \$15000.00 for the annual bond payments for the WWTP. Motion to approve to pay by Becky Evans, second by Wayne Cadro. Motion carries unanimously.

The council considered opening a new Checking Account at First State Bank Bédias for the GLO-MIT Grant Funding. Becky Evans made a motion to approve with Christina Stover, Curtis Darby and Donna Ray as Signatories with two signatures required on checks. Second by Gail Black. Motion carries unanimously.

The Mayor updated the council on the WWTP.

Finance Reports and Bank Statements were reviewed for approval. Motion to approve by Wayne Cadro, seconded by Becky Evans.
